# Summer Autism Training Institute 2019

## *Autism Beyond the Basics*

This 4-part workshop series is designed to provide teachers, therapist, and other educational professionals with an understanding of Applied Behavior Analysis/Verbal Behavior, visual supports and language development strategies. We will discuss and demonstrate the application of key behavioral principles and how they play out into increasing positive behaviors. Hands-on activities and video examples will add to the discussion and give participants specific strategies to incorporate into the classroom, therapy session or home.

While the curriculum of this series will focus on universal behavioral principles across the life span, **Ellenville** will focus on examples for preschool and young elementary aged students. In **Kingston** the focus will be on older elementary students through young adolescence. After choosing a site, **participants should plan to attend all 4 sessions.**
