

General Health Policies for Student Attendance

As of 5/11/22



For all general medical issues such as vomiting, diarrhea, temperatures - the school nurse will determine whether the student needs to go home.

Is It Covid?

We strongly encourage you to Covid test your child. This is the only way to determine whether their symptoms are Covid-related.

If your child tests for Covid and is positive

A child is able to return to school on day 6 if symptoms are improving. We will encourage the student to wear a mask at school and symptoms should be monitored at school and at home.

If your child is not tested for Covid

A child should remain home until symptoms are improving. **For vomiting, diarrhea, and fever** the student should be symptom free for 24-hours without the use of any type of over the counter medications before they return to school. When the student returns we will encourage the student to wear a mask at school for up to 5-days, and symptoms should be monitored at school and at home.

If symptoms re-occur at school following your child's return (vomiting, diarrhea, and fever)

Your child will need to be picked up and remain home until they are symptom-free for 24-hours without the use of any over the counter medications. When the student returns we will encourage them to wear a mask at school for up to 5-days and symptoms should be monitored at school and at home.

Alert your school nurse:

Please call the school nurse if your child tests positive, or if your child has a close contact out of school.
