

Instructions for Parent/Guardian of a Symptomatic Student



Our Center for Spectrum Services Covid Health Team has determined that your child is showing symptoms that may be associated with Covid. Please follow these instructions, so that your child can be allowed to return to school as quickly as possible:

- Your child should be tested for Covid using a home test kit, available through the school by calling our front office at 845-336-2616.
- If the test is negative, your child can return to school once they are showing no symptoms.
- If the test is positive, your child is able to return to school on day 6 if symptoms are improving. The student will be encouraged to wear a mask as tolerated in school until day 10, and should be monitored at home and school for symptoms.

Signs and symptoms of Covid include: fever, cough, tiredness, aches and pains, sore throat, vomiting, diarrhea, conjunctivitis, headache, loss of smell or taste, skin rash, difficulty breathing, chest pain or pressure, loss of speech or movement.
